

## Judge Daryl Todd

Judge Todd is a graduate of the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School with a BS in Economics and Duke University Law School (JD). He practiced law in Linwood and South Jersey for 33 years including representing various public bodies.

Judge Todd service on the Board of Education began in 1983 and continued for 17 years until he resigned in 2000 to accept the appointment to the Superior Court of New Jersey where he served until his retirement in 2012. During this prior service he helped lead the construction program to upgrade and expand both the Belhaven and Seaview schools. His return to the Board of Education is motivated in part by a desire to see continued advancements in curriculum and to participate in his life-long interest in education.

A Linwood resident since 1970, Daryl and his wife Mary raised their family in Linwood with all four children educated at Seaview and Belhaven Schools. Now six of their thirteen grandchildren continue the Linwood education tradition.

Judge Todd has served in a variety of leadership roles over the years in support of education including President of the Stockton College Foundation, President of the Holy Spirit High School Advisory Council and long service as a member of the Secondary School Committee of the University of Pennsylvania.
